Winter Courses

BIB 102 Old Testament Survey II (3 Credits)

A survey of the Biblical books of 1 Chronicles through
Ecclesiastes, with emphasis upon the message, major
themes, structure, and distinctive features of these books.
Students will use interpretational methods to evaluate Old
Testament theology and its influence on their New Testa-
ment understanding.

(Wednesdays, 10:10am-12:00pm)

BIB 104 Gospels and Life of Christ (2 Credits)

As they survey the Gospels, this course helps students grow
in their awareness of God's love for them and grow in their
love for Him and for one another. The purpose is Love.

(Thursdays, 8:00am-9:50am)

BIB 108 Pauline Epistles II (2 Credits)

Part one of a survey of the Apostle Paul's Epistles:
Ephesians, Philippians, Colossians, Philemon, 1 Timothy, 2
Timothy and Titus. Emphasis is given to the key cultural,
historical, doctrinal, and practical themes of these letters.
Practical life lessons from the life of the Apostle Paul are
also highlighted.

(Mondays, 10:10am-12:00pm)

CE 127 Prayer II (2 Credits)

This course offers students an in-depth look at prayer
through studying biblical passages and ministry lessons on
the subject, also featuring the unique and rich insights of
several qualified ministry leaders, and times of practical
application.

(Fridays, 10:10am-12:00pm)

CE 129 Relationship and Family (2 Credits)

This course offers an in-depth look at the biblical
principles of dating/courtship, marriage and family.

(Fridays, 8:00am-9:50am)

TH 112 Christian Theology II (4 Credits)

A survey of Christian theology, emphasizing a systematic
approach to studying the essential teachings of the Christian
faith as revealed in the Christian Scriptures. Specifically,
this course focuses on the doctrines of: the Bible and God.
