

Romans Quiz 3 Review

My beloved students,

Wish I could be with you today to continue your adventure through Romans. Instead I will be with Kari (woohoo!) in a marriage counseling course at Multnomah. So, even if I can't be there with you, at least we are happily in God's good, perfect and pleasing will together.

Here's the information you've all been waiting for ... (drum roll...)

Sitting in your email inbox today will be an email with THREE attached documents, each making up part of Quiz 3.

1. *The first part can be taken with the help of one-another* (in community!), and is thus open classmate as well as open Bible and notes.
2. *The second part is to be taken individually*, but is open Bible and notes.
3. *The third part is Scripture memorization* (10 pts). Note that the only required passages are in chapters 9-13 (see below); optional sections are in chs. 10-15. (I may give some extra credit for proving memorization of more than the required 10 pts.)

Keep in mind that while parts one and two are "open" in some ways, you will still want to refresh and study the material (notes and Bible text). I will be asking questions from Romans 13-16 as Adam teaches those to you, and you now have all the notes (note that all course notes are on the course webpage).

Re-reading out-loud through Romans 9-16 is an effective way to study the text again.

The Quiz will focus on Romans 9-16 but also draw on the main themes and concepts of the entire book, especially attempting to make connections among the whole. It is open Bible to help us see these connections.

10:9-10 **11:33** **12:1-2** **13:14** (6 pts)

Choose 4 pts from:
9:6; **10:4**; **10:17**; **11:22**; **12:4-5** (2 pts); **13:1**; **15:8-9** (2 pts)

All three parts need to be returned to me via email by 5:00pm on Thursday, June 12 (plan ahead as to not be late). Please keep them in rich text format (.rtf) when you return them. Oh, and by the way, there is not a time limit on the Quiz but I anticipate it taking you 60-90 minutes total at the most.
